- advance next generation influenza vaccines

- draw on new & multi-disciplinary knowledge
- include all stakeholders, from lab to market: research, pre-clinical trials & vaccine developers

Project consortium must include at least three legal entities from the EU
(from three different Member States/Associated countries to Horizon 2020)
PLUS three legal entities from India
