## Indo-French Workshop

March 22-24, 2025

### Background:

The Indo-French Workshop on **Artificial Intelligence, Healthcare, and the Way Forward for India and France** is funded by the **Indo-French Centre for the Promotion of Advanced Research (IFCPR/CEFIPRA)** and supported by the **All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)**, Delhi, India, **Paris Brain Institute (ICM)**, France, and the **Integrated Health programme (Sorbonne University)**, Paris, and **Indian Institute of Technology (IIT)**, Delhi).

The **Integrated Health programme** is part of the **Franco-Indian Campus** funded by the French government to bring together universities, research institutions, hospitals, start-ups and corporate entities to jointly develop and deliver higher education and research programs in the field of life sciences for health. The ambition of the campus is to create a shared ecosystem to promote an integrated and transversal approach able to address global health challenges and to enrich the research and academic environments of both countries by promoting the cross-mobility of students, faculty and researchers across the Indo-Pacific region.

### Objective:

The aim of this workshop is to unite researchers, clinicians, and early-career scientists from India and France to discuss advancements in digital health, AI, and medical sciences, fostering collaborations and building a strong Indo-French research ecosystem.
